Your profile

A successful application requires:

- Excellent Ukrainian skills, spoken and written, solid English skills
- Motivation and ability to work independently on assigned tasks
- Knowledge (e.g. bachelor's degree) in Geography, (Political) Ecology or Agrarian Studies would be an asset
- Experience with social science research methods (online research, qualitative text analysis, surveys, quantitative methods) would be an asset
- You should be enrolled at a Swiss university

Your application (in English or German) should include a motivation statement (approx. 1 page), a curriculum vitae and relevant degree transcripts (diplomas etc.).
